The core components of the LYS program have remained consistent throughout the past 50 years. Definitions of some of the core components of the LYS week are below: :

delegate

\ 'de-li-gət

a student participant of the Louisiana Youth Seminar

staff

/staf/

(aka "red shirts") volunteer college students and young professionals embodying the principal of "Forever Young" who implement the annual seminar (includes roles of Program Director/Executive Director, Assistant Program Directors, Staff Assistants, **Counselors and Junior Counselors**)

home group

/hōm//groop/

a diverse group of delegates mentored by a counselor and junior counselor who spend most of their time together through the week of LYS. Home Groups are named based on the annual theme and compete against, or work with, one another in the various sessions and competitions throughout the week.

speakers

/'spēkər/

Elected officials, community leaders, University officials who inspire and inform the delegation as guest speakers annually. The first external speaker was Senator Ellender in 1972.

tory/whig

/'tôrē// /(h)wig/

political parties of the LYS political party system in which delegates embrace the importance of our freedom of speech and voting. Through the process, delegates run for officer positions by giving speeches, voting and executing a caucus filled with strategy and a whole lot of fun. Delegates get a complete look at the political process with an LYS twist. (Mascots: Tory= Chicken & Whig = Pig)

competitions

planned and surprise contests throughout the week in which home groups compete against one another to win awards and earn points toward the ultimate goal of winning group of the day/group of week- symbolized by the coveted LYS flag. (Competitions include: Skit, Song, Group of the Day)

belief

LYS was founded on the belief that if businesses, communities and government are to have effective leaders in the future, we must help our students to develop their core leadership skills such as effective communication, setting and achieving goals, team building, understanding and accepting others, developing self confidence, conducting effective meetings, and problem solving skills.

LYS is held for one week each summer during the third week of July. The Louisiana Youth Seminar is a leadership camp designed for high school juniors and seniors (and sophomores who are up for the challenge). Approximately 300 students attend from throughout the state.

With the support of Senator Landrieu, LYS was the recipient of a \$148,000 Department of Education Grant in 2005 which enabled LYS to establish a tuition waiver progream and provide a stipend for a part-time Executive Director. That year, Sonja Pruitt-Lord was hired as the LYS Executive Director of which she remains a dedicated servant leader to this day.

I hope you become frustrated and dissatisfied enough to begin to push back the very barriers of your own personality limitations.


I hope you make a stupid unethical mistake and get caught red handed and are big enough to say those magic words, "I was wrong."

I wish for you a magnificent obsession that will give you a reason for living and purpose and direction and élan and life.


I wish for you the worst kind of criticism for everything you do because that makes you fight to achieve beyond what you normally would.

I wish for you the experience of leadership.





Roddy Richard **1965-1986**

Roddy Richard came to LYS from Teurlings Catholic High and joined Staff in 1983. Roddy was an exceptional young man whose life was taken in a tragic accident. To celebrate his life and honor his spirit LYS created the Roddy Richard Life Achievement Award, which recognizes an outstanding individual each year whose character and purpose in life has lessened the burden of others and made this a better place for their fellow man.

In honor of his memory, since 1988 we have annually selected a Louisiana native who shows the same compassion and fervor as Roddy himself as the recipient of the Roddy Richard Life Achievement Award.






